- 1. All riders must be 4 years or over on 1st January in the current year.
- 2. One Day Event & Cross Country entries to: Hazel West, Spinney View, Booth Bed Lane, Allostock, Cheshire WA16 9NQ. Tel: 01565 723976. Entries to be received by the Wednesday lunchtime prior to the event. For allocated start times <a href="https://www.wilmslowridingclub.co.uk">www.wilmslowridingclub.co.uk</a>, Horsemonkey or telephone Hazel West Tel: 01565 723976 not before 6.30pm or after 8.30pm on the Friday evening prior to the event.
- 3. Please do not expect the organiser to telephone you back.
- 4. One Day Event June Green Trophy to the WRC member with the best score in any class/section at both One Day Events.
- 5. Trophies awarded to all class winners. Annual Trophies will be awarded to WRC members gaining the most points in both the Cross Country and One Day Events.
- 6. Matthiesen Trophy to be presented to the 'Rider with the Best Style' in the Novice sections at the April Cross Country, if a member of W.R.C. To be judged over a selection of fences. For more information contact the secretary.
- 7. The time for the presentation of prizes will be posted on the Secretary's Window. Correct dress must be worn for presentations.
- 8. Protective headgear to at least EN1384 or PAS015 (No fixed peak hats), body protectors BETA Level 3 or above and medical armbands must be worn on cross country course.
- 9. Competitors must see Course Plan on Secretary's Window for details of Optimum Times which are used to decide winner.
- 10. Competitors must declare to Secretary at least 30 minutes before their starting time and pay a £10 refundable deposit on their number bib. **Please bring correct money.**
- 11. In the event of cancellation, all entry cheques will be destroyed and cash will be refunded at next WRC event.
- 12. Please also see Club Rules on Page 33, including stallions Rule 5.
- 13. Rosettes to 6th place in all classes/sections.
- 14. No Stopwatches Allowed
- 15. Times for walking the Show Jumping Course (ODE) will be displayed when collecting your number or on the website.
- 16 No Horse/ Pony may compete in more than one class on the same day, except in the Pairs Cross Country Class. No Starters may compete in the Pairs.
- 17. If your times are not on the website, please contact the organiser.
- 18. Time for walking the Cross Country course for both the Cross Country and One Day Event From 2 p.m. on the Saturday prior to the event.
- 19. ODE & XC Challenge Any rider incurring more than 24 faults, being eliminated or in the opinion of the Show Jumping judge is not safe, will not be allowed to commence the Cross Country phase. BE rule.
